MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING Between the WESTSIDE UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT and WESTSIDE UNION TEACHERS ASSOCIATION

This Agreement is between the Westside Union Teachers Association (“WUTA”) and Westside Union School District regarding the Extended Day Reading Intervention Program that will be offered during the 2024-25 school year.

The Extended Day Reading Intervention program will be offered at sites across the district consist of the following:

- 7 Week sessions with students attending 3 days per week (Typically, Tues-Thursday)
- Daily sessions will begin 15 minutes after school ends and run for 45 minutes
- Selected teachers provide supervision of dismissal on these days
- Class size will be approximately 15 students
- Teachers will be required take attendance through a district/centralized data management system.
- Students will be assessed through NWEA with results documented in a district/centralized data management system.
- Communication of progress to parents and homeroom teachers
- Teachers will provide direct, explicit phonics instruction using Decoding Power
 - Linda Mood Bell may be used for Tier III intervention for students not showing progress with Decoding Power. Staff will work with site admin to determine these Tier III groups.
- K-2 programs will be the initial priority
 - If priorities are met and the program extends to upper grades, instruction with Read 180 may be used.


Selection of Teachers:

- Current or past experience in grade level
- Participated in the Core Reading Program or currently enrolled
- Clear Credential Preferred
- Current staff member at school site
- Most recent evaluation has all satisfactory marks


Salary:

- 4.5 total hours per week paid at teacher’s hourly rate calculated from base salary on salary schedule
- Any additional required training will be paid at the same hourly rate
